On behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four, you and your staff are invited to a Public Hearing for the Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study for the above referenced project. A PD&E Study is FDOT's process to evaluate the social, economic and environmental impacts associated with a planned transportation improvement project. The purpose of this project is to evaluate bridge replacement alternatives that will address existing deficiencies on the bridge, to provide for appropriate pedestrian and bicycle facilities, and to enhance emergency evacuation within the study limits.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried out by Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 14, 2016, and executed by Federal Highway Administration and FDOT.

The Hearing is scheduled for **Tuesday, October 24, 2017, starting at 5:30 p.m. at the Jupiter Community Center, 200 Military Trail, Jupiter, FL 33458**. The Public Hearing will begin at 5:30 p.m. as an open house. A formal presentation will begin at 6:30 p.m., followed by a comment period. Persons wishing to submit written statements or other exhibits, in place of or in addition to oral statements, may do so at the hearing or by sending them to me at 3400 West Commercial Boulevard, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33309. All exhibits or statements postmarked on or before November 3, 2017, will become part of the Public Hearing record. In the event that the Public Hearing cannot be held on October 24, 2017 due to severe weather or other unforeseen conditions, it will be held on the alternate date of Wednesday, November 15, 2017 at the same time and place.

Notices are being sent to all property owners and tenants located within at least 300 feet on either side of the proposed alignment and to other public officials, regulatory agencies, organizations, and individuals interested in the project. Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, religion, disability or family status. Persons who require special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) or persons who require translation services (free of charge) should contact me, at least seven (7) days prior to the Public Hearing.

If you would like to review the project documents prior to the Public Hearing, they will be available to the public beginning on Tuesday, October 3, 2017, at the Jupiter Library, 705 Military Trail, Jupiter, FL 33458 (Monday through Thursday, 9 a.m. - 8 p.m., Friday, 9 a.m. - 6 p.m., Saturday, 9 a.m. - 5 p.m. and Sunday, 12 p.m. - 5 p.m.) and at FDOT – District Four, 3400 West Commercial Boulevard, Ft. Lauderdale, FL 33309 (Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.). The documents will remain on display through November 3, 2017 and on the project website at www.jupiterus1bridge.com.
